1 BY MR. PRATT:

2 Q On August 10, you placed a mortgage on that
3 property; is that right?

4 A Yes, sir.

5 Q For how much?

6 A For \$180,000.

7 Q Did you receive the \$180,000?

8 A I gave it to Mr. Whitman.

9 Q So at the time that Mr. Whitman transferred half
10 of the interest to you, you paid him the sum of \$180,000

20 that time?

22 property.

23 Q For how much?

24 A For \$140,000.

25 Q Did you still own the house on Willow Avenue?

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1 A No. I couldn't keep it up, so I sold it.

2 Q When did you sell the house, Mrs. Whitman?

3 A I sold it in December 2015.

4 Q Was there any income from that house?

5 A No, sir.

6 Q During the period from August 10 until the
7 separation agreement, what was your source of support?

8 A The only support I had, my family gave me.

9 MR. DRAKE: I object as immaterial.

10 THE COURT: No, I will take it. This man got a
11 separation agreement. She said he obtained it by fraud,
12 duress, and for many other reasons. Let us find out
13 what it is about.

14 MR. PRATT: Your Honor --

15 THE COURT: I am ruling with you. Don't argue or I
16 will change my mind.

17 BY MR. PRATT:

18 Q This property was not providing anything to your
19 support, was it?

20 A No.

21 MR. DRAKE: I object to the form of the question.

22 THE COURT: I will let it stand. She said no. Let
23 the answer stand.

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
